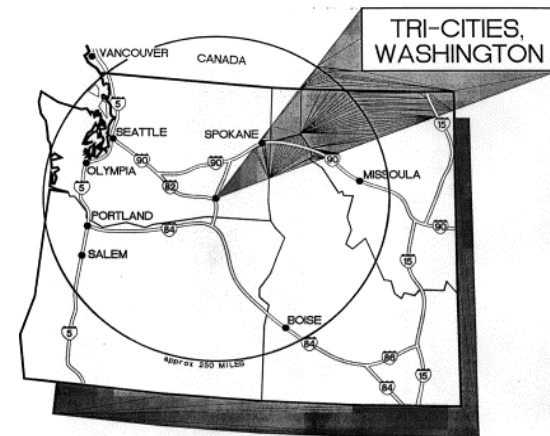
City Information:
